**Applied Learning Courses
(2022-24 Cohort; 2024 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination)
Arrangement Details for Early Course Commencement
at Secondary 4 in the 2021/22 School Year**

The purpose of this letter is to inform schools of the details of implementation of the Applied Learning (ApL) courses at Secondary 4 (S4) in the 2021/22 school year and facilitate interested schools to make early arrangements.

Details

2. Currently, students generally begin to take ApL courses at S5 and complete at S6. Schools may consider offering courses at S4, allowing students to start taking the courses at S4 and complete at S5. Students taking ApL courses at S4 should apply for entering ApL subjects¹ in Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination of the respective year at S6.
3. For the ApL courses in the 2022-24 cohort, schools may refer to Annex 1 and Annex 2 for the arrangements for early course commencement at S4. As for the arrangements for offering the ApL courses at S5², the Education Bureau (EDB) will issue a circular memorandum to announce the details later.
4. If your school intends to offer ApL course(s) at S4 in the 2021/22 school year, please submit applications for students via the “ApL Module” in the WebSAMS during the period from **3 May to 1 June 2021** and arrange for students to participate in the selection arrangements to be subsequently announced by the course providers. Schools may make reference to the WebSAMS application procedures as set out in the

¹ If students take ApL courses of the 2022-24 cohort at S4 in the 2021/22 school year, they should register for entry to ApL subjects in the 2024 HKDSE Examination at S6.

² Schools can arrange students studying S4 in the 2021/22 school year to apply for taking the ApL courses of the 2022-24 cohort at S5 and S6, and register for entry to ApL subjects in the 2024 HKDSE Examination.

“User Manual for Applied Learning” uploaded on the EDB website: cdr.websams.edb.gov.hk/ (path: home page > module information > Applied Learning > user manual).

5. Schools may adopt two modes in offering ApL courses according to the school context: for Mode 1, lessons are in general held at the venues of the course providers; for Mode 2 (i.e. schools could offer courses on their own or through collaboration with other schools), lessons are in general held on the school campus. **Schools intending to offer courses in Mode 2 have to reach an initial agreement and formulate the implementation details with the relevant course provider(s)**, which will include timetable and teaching arrangement. Schools interested in offering ApL courses through collaboration with other schools should complete and return Annex 3 to express intention to the EDB on or before 7 May 2021.

6. In order to facilitate students to make informed choices on ApL courses, apart from providing guidance support, schools could encourage students to visit the ApL website of the EDB (www.edb.gov.hk/apl/en) for more information about ApL courses. Schools could also collect copies of the course prospectus from the EDB and disseminate them to students for their reference. Details will be announced via the Communication and Delivery System of the WebSAMS in mid-March.

Funding Arrangement

7. All aided, government and Direct Subsidy Scheme secondary schools, caput schools and special schools operating senior secondary classes offering ApL courses approved by the EDB are eligible for the Diversity Learning Grant (DLG) to pay for the course fees. These schools are NOT allowed to charge students any course fee. Please refer to the funding and accounting arrangements at Annex 4.

8. Starting from the 2020/21 school year, if individual students take an ApL course as the 4th elective subject, their schools will also be subsidised by the DLG to encourage students to take ApL to broaden their learning experience.

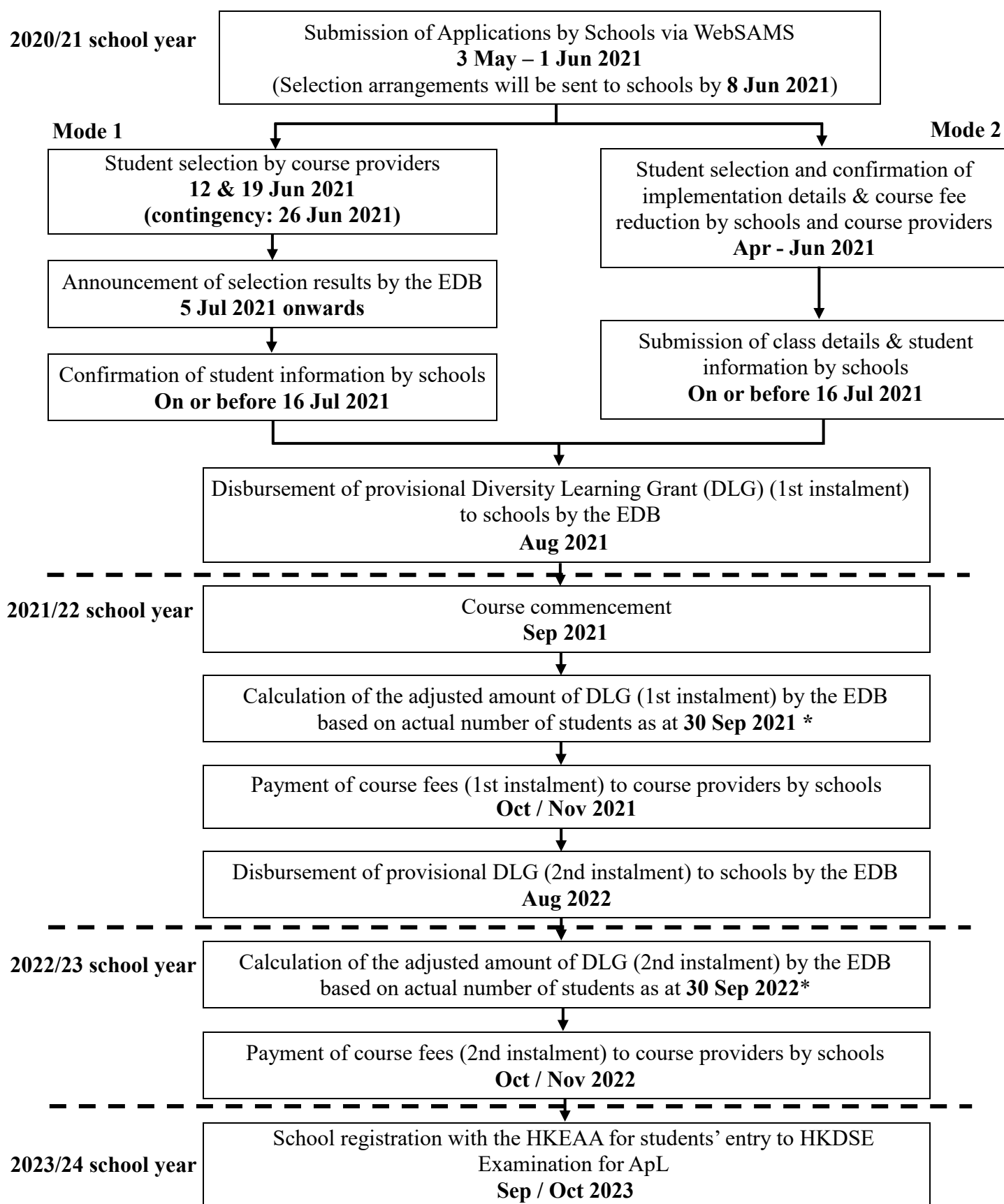

註三 NOTE 3

為探討應用學習的課程發展方向和推行模式，包括引入更多業界的參與，應用學習試點課程「資訊科技精要」在 2019/20 學年開始試行。參與計劃的機構包括課程提供機構香港浸會大學持續教育學院及試行的學校。「資訊科技精要」將繼續於 2021/22 學年試行。除試行的學校外，2022-24 年度的課程將以模式一公開接受申請，並將於 2021 年 9 月在中四級開課。有意報讀課程的學生（適用於將於 2021/22 學年就讀中四級的學生）須透過就讀學校申請，並參與課程提供機構其後安排的甄選程序。 To explore the future direction of curriculum development and implementation modes of ApL, including greater engagement of industries, a pilot ApL course “Tech Basics” is being tried out since 2019/20 school year. The participating organisations include the course provider (School of Continuing Education, Hong Kong Baptist University) and the pilot schools. “Tech Basics” will continue to be tried out in the 2021/22 school year. In addition to the pilot schools, the course will be open for Mode 1 applications for the 2022-24 cohort, which will commence at Secondary 4 in September 2021. Students (applicable to those who will study secondary 4 in the 2021/22 school year) intending to apply for the course should submit their applications through schools and participate in the interview processes to be arranged by the course provider later.

Diversity Learning Grant for Applied Learning Courses

(2022-24 Cohort; 2024 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination)

(Applicable for Early Course Commencement at Secondary 4 in the 2021/22 School Year)

Diversity Learning Grant

1. The Diversity Learning Grant (DLG) supports all aided, government and Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) secondary schools, caput schools and special schools operating senior secondary classes, in offering a diversified curriculum to cater for students' needs. It is a cash grant for aided secondary schools, DSS secondary schools, caput schools and special schools. For government secondary schools, it is in the form of budget allocation.

2. The DLG will be provided to eligible schools on a yearly basis for the implementation of ApL courses provided by the course providers and approved by the Education Bureau (EDB). Schools receiving the DLG are NOT allowed to charge students any course fees. To streamline school administration, schools are no longer required to draw up a three-year plan on broadening subject choices for a particular cohort of students.

Ambit

3. Students in eligible schools studying the senior secondary curriculum recommended by the Curriculum Development Council and studying ApL courses are subsidised under the DLG¹. Each eligible student is entitled to funding for **a maximum of two** ApL courses (excluding Applied Learning Chinese (for non-Chinese speaking students)). In addition, from the 2020/21 school year onwards, if individual students **take an ApL course as the 4th elective subject, the school will also be subsidised by the DLG²**.

4. The DLG for ApL courses (2022-24 cohort) can only be used to subsidise students to take ApL courses for the 2022-24 cohort and cannot be mixed with the DLG for other cohorts of ApL courses. The funding must be used for the payment of ApL course fees to be charged by the course providers. It must not be used for Other Languages and Other Programmes (which are supported by other categories of the DLG), and other purposes such as capital purchases, overheads or maintenance, etc.

Funding Arrangement

5. Schools will be allocated with an amount of DLG which is equal to the total course fee of ApL courses enrolled by eligible students. The DLG for ApL courses (2022-24 cohort) will be allocated to schools in **two equal instalments** during the two-year course duration. The first and second instalments of the DLG will be provisionally disbursed to schools in August 2021 and August 2022 respectively. For government secondary schools, the DLG will be provided to schools in the form of budget allocations. Adjustments to the DLG, if any, will be made by the EDB based on the actual number of students taking ApL courses (2022-24 cohort) (as at **30 September of the respective**

¹ Students no longer meeting the requirements as stated in paragraph 3 above due to any reason (e.g. departed from schools) will not be eligible for the DLG for ApL. However, if such students have successfully completed their first year study of ApL courses, they may continue their second year study of ApL courses at their own expense with the consent of the respective course providers and the EDB.

² In case a student also takes the adapted ApL course(s), each adapted ApL course will be counted as an ApL course in the funding arrangement.

school years) and the information submitted by schools.

Accounting Arrangements

6. Schools should make use of the DLG to pay course fees to the course providers in two equal instalments. Instalments of course fees would be calculated based on the number of students as at **30 September** of the respective school years. Besides, schools may apply for course fee reduction from the course providers should there be venues, facilities, equipment provided or school teachers contributing to the teaching of ApL courses, etc.. If necessary and under special circumstances, schools can deploy the resources tabulated below for the payment of ApL course fees.

Upon deployment of resources, if schools still have genuine financial difficulties in offering ApL courses, schools may approach the Applied Learning Section of the EDB **on or before 30 July 2021** to set out their difficulties. The EDB will provide support as far as possible taking into account the specific situation of individual schools.

7. For aided secondary schools, DSS secondary schools, caput schools and special schools, a separate ledger account named “**DLG for ApL courses (2022-24 cohort)**” should be kept in the school ledger account under the **Government Fund** to properly record all income and expenditure chargeable to ApL courses. The surplus in the ledger account can be carried forward to the next school year until **31 August 2024**. Any unspent balance of the DLG will be clawed back. In case of deficit in the ledger account, schools can top up the DLG by deploying other resources by the end of the respective school years.

8. For government secondary schools, the expenditure should be charged to the user code assigned for ApL courses (2022-24 cohort). Unspent balance of the allocations as at the end of each financial year (**i.e. 31 March of each year during the two-year course duration**) cannot be carried forward to the subsequent financial year and will lapse. In case of deficit, schools can top up the DLG by deploying the resources as set out above (paragraph 6).
