

Constitution and Basic Law Online Learning Course for Upper Primary and Junior Secondary Students

Purpose

This is to inform primary and secondary school heads and teachers about the captioned online learning course.

Details

2. To support the promotion of Constitution and Basic Law education in schools, as well as to foster students' sense of law-abidingness and national identity, the Education Bureau (EDB) produced the "Constitution and Basic Law Online Learning Course for Upper Primary and Junior Secondary Students" for students' self-learning. The online course comprises "learning zone", "game zone" and "challenge zone". Through daily life examples, animations, games, etc., it enables students to understand the relationship between the Constitution and the Basic Law, as well as the close relationship between the Basic Law and our daily lives, in an interesting and interactive manner, and foster students' proper values and attitudes.

3. As 4th April is the Commemoration Day for the Promulgation of the Basic Law, schools could seize the opportunity to encourage students to make good use of learning time to conduct self-learning through the above online platform, so as to enable them to know more about the origin of the Basic Law, as well as how the Constitution and the Basic Law safeguards the prosperity and stability of Hong Kong.

4. Upper primary and junior secondary students can login to the Online Learning Course (website: <http://cble.edb.hkedcity.net/student>) with their Hong Kong Education City (HKEdCity) accounts. To encourage students' active participation, an electronic certificate will be awarded to each student upon successful completion of online learning of Module 1 to 6. Moreover, students joining the Constitution and Basic Law Student Ambassadors Training Scheme of the EDB will be given two reward points after completion of this course.
