A boy said he likes me and asked me to let him touch my breast. He even said that I should answer him if I loved him. Although I also like him and don't want to lose a friend, I feel uncomfortable about that and rejected him at the end. Did I do the right thing?



YES! You did a great job! We have the right to protect our own private parts, and we should not let others touch us casually. We should **stand up against** these unreasonable requests.
