Notice to Participating Schools

1. Objectives

Stories of the Hong Kong Palace Museum Treasures – Picture Book Creating Competition (Primary) 2024/25 is co-organised by the Arts Education (AE) Section of the Curriculum Development Institute (CDI), Education Bureau (EDB) and the Hong Kong Palace Museum (HKPM). The competition aims to encourage primary students to appreciate the traditional Chinese treasures of the HKPM, and to apply knowledge of and skill in visual arts and language to create picture books for nurturing their aesthetics, creativity, proper values and attitudes, as well as developing their national identity.

2. Division

Lower Primary Division (Primary 1 to 3) Upper Primary Division (Primary 4 to 6)

3. Theme

The themes of the competition include "Filial Piety", "Perseverance" and "Diligence". Participants are required to select one of the themes to create picture books, and use treasures on display in the thematic exhibition "Passion for Collecting: Founding Donations to the Hong Kong Palace Museum" in Gallery 6 of the HKPM as characters to convey the message(s) of the chosen theme.

5. Entry Requirements

Number of pages of each entry:

Lower Primary Division: 4 - 8 pages;

Upper Primary Division: 6 - 12 pages

- Participants may refer to the layout (Annex c or/and Annex d) to create picture books.
- The picture books can be wordless. If text is included, please note the following:
 - text should be written below the drawing panel;
 - suitable space should be reserved in the drawing for our team to input the text during layout;
 - no more than 30 words in Chinese or English per page; and
 - write down the page number at the bottom of each page.
- Participants may use any media (e.g. colour pencil, marker pen, wash drawing, digital drawing) to create their picture books.
- Participants should select at least one of the treasures on display in the thematic exhibition "Passion for Collecting: Founding Donations to the Hong Kong Palace Museum" in Gallery 6 of the HKPM as characters for their picture books. All image(s) and information of referred treasure(s) should be listed on the List of Treasures Reference (Annex e).
- The picture books should express one of the themes: "Filial Piety", "Perseverance" or "Diligence".
- Each entry should be saved separately in PDF format, with resolution of not less than 300dpi.
- Use "01", "02"... as the filenames of your school's entries. The sequence of number should be the same as the order of submitting entry information online.
- Book synopsis (Annex b) must be in Chinese or English (no more than 50 words for Lower Primary Division and no more than 100 words for Upper Primary Division respectively).

6. Rules and Regulations

- Participants should be full-time students of primary schools in Hong Kong.
- Each entry should correspond to the theme, and should be the original and unpublished work of the participant.
- Each entry should be submitted on an individual basis.
- Each participant can submit only **ONE** entry.
- Each school may submit a maximum of 20 entries.
 - (i) Lower Primary Division: Up to 12 entries;
 - (ii) Upper Primary Division: Up to 12 entries.
- All entries should be submitted through the school of the participants.

7. Adjudication

- The adjudication panel comprises representatives of the EDB and the HKPM and art professionals/practitioners.
- All entries will be assessed according to the following criteria:
 - (i) communication of the theme;
 - (ii) mastery of visual language, medium and techniques;
 - (iii) originality and creativity;
 - (iv) writing skill; and
 - (v) storyline.
- The decision of the adjudication panel will be final.
