Stories of the Hong Kong Palace Museum Treasure – Handmade Picture Book Creating Competition (Secondary) 2024/25

Notice to Participating Schools

1. Objectives

Stories of the Hong Kong Palace Museum Treasures – Handmade Picture Book Creating Competition (Secondary) 2024/25 is co-organised by the Arts Education (AE) Section of the Curriculum Development Institute (CDI), Education Bureau (EDB) and the Hong Kong Palace Museum (HKPM). The competition aims to encourage secondary students to appreciate the traditional Chinese treasures of the HKPM, and to apply knowledge of and skill in visual arts and language to create handmade picture books for nurturing their aesthetics, creativity, proper values and attitudes, as well as developing their national identity.

2. Theme

The themes of the competition include "Filial Piety", "Perseverance" and "Diligence". Participants are required to select one theme to create handmade picture books by using treasures on display in the thematic exhibition "Passion for Collecting: Founding Donations to the Hong Kong Palace Museum" in Gallery 6 of the HKPM as characters to convey the message(s) of the chosen theme.

4. Entry Requirements

- No limit on the number of pages, size, media, materials, shape and form
- The handmade picture book can be wordless. Please note the following if text is included:
 - text should not be written or printed on the pages of the handmade picture book, but to be submitted separately online with the corresponding page number (Annex c);
 - available space for the text should be reserved on the corresponding page of the handmade picture book; and
 - no more than 30 words in Chinese or English per page.
- Participants may use any media (e.g. drawing, collage, embroidery, digital art), materials (e.g. paper, wood, fabric, ceramics) and form (e.g. pop-up book, miniature book, scroll) to create the handmade picture book.
- Participants should select at least one of the treasures on display in the thematic exhibition "Passion for Collecting: Founding Donations to the Hong Kong Palace Museum" in Gallery 6 of the HKPM as characters for their handmade picture books. All referred treasure(s) should be listed on the List of Treasures Reference (Annex e).
- The handmade picture book should select one theme from "Filial Piety", "Perseverance" and "Diligence" to convey proper values and attitudes of inheriting traditional Chinese culture.
- Please use "01", "02"... as the filenames of your school's entries, the sequence of number should be the same as the order of submitting entry information online.
- Book synopsis in Chinese or English (no more than 100 words) should be submitted (Annex b).

5. Rules and Regulations

- Participants should be full-time students of secondary schools in Hong Kong.
- Each entry should correspond to the theme, and should be the original and unpublished work of the participant.
- Each entry should be submitted on an individual basis.
- Each participant can submit only ONE entry.
- All entries should be submitted through the school of the participants.

6. Adjudication

- The adjudication panel comprises representatives of the EDB and the HKPM and art professionals/practitioners.
- All entries will be assessed according to the following criteria:
 - (i) communication of the theme;
 - (ii) mastery of visual language, medium and techniques;
 - (iii) originality and creativity; and
 - (iv) storyline.
- The decision of the adjudication panel will be final.
