## From Reading to Building a Loving Community

### Reading Promotion

Together is better.

"Together is Better", a book about love, the joy of service and leadership, was used as an entry point to promote proper values and attitudes (e.g. unity, benevolence) in the school curriculum. The story provided inspirations for cultivating a culture of support and collaboration as well as nurturing a loving community. Introduced in the English reading lessons, the story was further exploited to extend students' reading experiences beyond the classroom.

### Student Leadership

Leadership is about taking care of those in your charge.

Inspired by the insights from the book, S5 students took a leading role as student ambassadors to plan and implement a series of learning activities (e.g. game booths, props design, decorations) and promoted it to the S4 and S1 students for feedback on the activity design and recruitment of student helpers. The activity week fostered bonds over a shared vision, further strengthened connection across levels and promoted a supportive learning environment.

### The Power of Collaboration

Life is beautiful because of the people we meet.

Under the fun-filled atmosphere, the importance of team work and collaboration promoted in the book was realised in the activity week. The student ambassadors learnt to rely on each other and applied their creativity and problem-solving skills to ensure effective implementation of the activities. The learning games were also designed to engage student participants in placing trust in their peers and collaborating with each other in order to complete the challenges.
