

## **LPF Listening Exemplar**

**Maria**

### **Task Description**

In this listening activity, students listened to a poem about a good friend and responded to questions related to the poem.

### **Preparation**

Before the listening activity, the teacher guided students to share their personal experience with good friends by asking the following questions:

- Do you have good friends? How do you describe them?
- What do you like to do with your good friends?
- Why do you think a friend is good? What does he/she do?

How does Susan feel about Maria?</p> <p>She <u>likes/loves</u> Maria because <u>they are both so different and they are both the same/they are (best) friends.</u> (Accept any acceptable answers.)</p>	<p>ATM 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>understand Susan’s feelings by using <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- semantic clues, e.g. ‘We are friends, we are friends, we are best friends!’</li> <li>- syntactic clues, e.g. the repeated structure ‘we are friends’ and the superlative adjective ‘best’ to emphasise their friendship</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

## **Tapescript**

<b>Narrator:</b>	<i>Susan is reading aloud a poem she wrote. It is about her friend, Maria. The poem will be played two times. Listen to the poem and answer Question 1. Then listen again and answer Questions 2 to 4.</i>
<b>Susan:</b>	<b>[Maria</b> I've got a good friend and Maria is her name. We love riding our bikes and playing many games. My favourite colour's green, her favourite colour's blue. I like going to the cinema, she likes going to the zoo. I am from China and she is from Spain. We are both so different and we are both the same! We are friends, we are friends, we are best friends!]
<b>Narrator:</b>	<i>Now answer Question 1.* (10-second pause)</i>
<b>Narrator:</b>	<i>Now listen to the poem again and answer Questions 2 to 4. [Repeat]</i>
<b>Narrator:</b>	<i>Now answer Questions 2 to 4.* (15-second pause)</i>
<b>Narrator:</b>	<i>That's the end of the listening task.</i>
