# LPF Listening Exemplar

## May's Visit to Hong Kong

### **Task Description**

In this listening activity, students listened to a conversation between May and her mother about their trip to Hong Kong. They then completed a letter for May to tell her grandfather about her visit to Hong Kong.

# **Preparation**

Before the listening activity, the teacher introduced the topic by eliciting students' prior knowledge and personal experience of going on a trip to other places. The teacher also helped students predict the content of May's letter to her grandfather by asking the following questions:

- Where will May and her mother stay in Hong Kong?
- What places will they visit?
- What will they see and do in Hong Kong?

a letter to tell Grandfather about it.\* (5-second pause)
