SUMMARY

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to inform primary and secondary schools of the organisation of the Smart City Project Exhibition cum Prize-presentation Ceremony of the "Smart City Project Programme 2023/24" by the Education Bureau (EDB).

BACKGROUND

- 2. To strengthen students' understanding of Smart City and further develop their creativity, data literacy and capability in the applications of Mathematics, EDB collaborates with tertiary institutions, professional organisations, and other government departments ¹ to organise the "Smart City Project Programme" in this school year (2023/24). We have provided students and teachers with a variety of activities, including smart city project learning activities, the online quiz "Smart City Knowledge Challenge" (SCKC), seminars, workshops and visits. Schools were highly engaged in the above activities and the events were smoothly conducted.
- 3. We plan to organise the Smart City Project Exhibition cum Prize-presentation Ceremony in late-November 2024 to showcase the student projects selected by the adjudication panel. Students' learning outcomes will also be celebrated in the prize-presentation ceremony.
