
Title of School-based Support Service (Learning Communities) (2025/26):

Learning Community for Primary School Chinese Language Teachers: Support Non-Chinese Speaking Students to Learn Chinese



1. Objectives

The support service aims to:

- Enhance curriculum leadership and professional level of teacher team in participating schools through the train-the-trainer approach and with a focus on curriculum leadership
- Establish a platform for teachers who teach non-Chinese Speaking(NCS) students, sharing teaching and learning resources, experiences, and practical insights with other schools

2. Foci of Support

- To lead teachers in understanding the teaching plans, strategies, and assessments for supporting NCS students in learning Chinese, as well as enhance their effectiveness in teaching and learning through collaborative design, material development, and constructive feedback on classroom practices
- To assist teachers in analyzing the learning needs of NCS students, adjusting teaching and assessment strategies, and designing diversified language learning experiences to develop NCS students' confidence and interest in learning Chinese, while laying a solid foundation in the language

3. Support Activities

- Thematic seminars, cross-school lesson observations, as well as sharing sessions are organised to foster professional exchanges among teachers and promote practical experiences and effective resources
- On-site meetings are arranged to enhance curriculum planning and pedagogical design in response to students' abilities and needs

4. Points to note

- The support service normally lasts for one year
- To effectively utilise the support service, participating schools should:
 - appoint a teacher as the coordinator responsible for maintaining contact with the support officer of the service
 - provide administrative support in releasing participating teachers to attend all meetings as well as professional development activities organised; arrange internal meetings led by the teachers participating in this support service to discuss how to support lower primary NCS students to learn Chinese. Support officers will work closely with the teachers and provide feedback to further enhance their professional capacity
 - allow support officers to collect materials including video clips and photographs of learning activities, teachers' reflection and student work during the support period for professional discussion
 - share successful experiences in school curriculum development and the teaching
