Programme Description	Topics to be covered include the following: (a) Introducing the rhetorical structure of genres commonly found in content subjects (b) Developing 'detailed reading' as a means to facilitating students' comprehension of texts written in academic style in content subjects (c) Developing 'reading-to-write' approach to scaffold weaker students' and stretch stronger students' writing (d) Introducing strategies for coping with vocabulary in content subjects (e) Demonstrating specific strategies for catering for learner diversity in the Mathematics, Science and Humanities subjects (f) Designing, conducting and evaluating pedagogic activities for catering for learner diversity in the content subjects
