(The two Narrators come out and face each other)

Narrator 2: Yes, I wanted to be a lawyer, or a doctor, maybe a fireman! Someone who can make a difference!

Narrator 1: But as you grow up, you will find out that it's not always so easy to reach your goals.

Narrator 1: (Facing the audience) Well, let us tell you a story.

Narrator 2: Once upon a time, there was a school called "The Mighty School".

Scene Two

- Moon: Look at this boy! He's stargazing again, such curiosity, wonders, and amazement about the universe!
- Star: Of course, he is the son of a famous scientist!
- Earth: Of all the scientists that dwell within me, he is the youngest and the most talented I have ever seen!
- Sun: But he does not have a strong will! He cares too much about the opinions of others and gives up easily!
- Mercury: How can he be stronger?
- Mars: He is still young! He will meet good friends and teachers who are willing to support him!
- Moon: Yes, but the most important thing is to have a determined mind.
- Star: Shhhh... he is still speaking to us! Listen!
- Newton:However, people don't seem to understand the value of my invention. They only care about my classmate Plato! If I don't get the recognition like him, why should I work so hard?
- Earth: He still has so much to learn - success is never easy. I have seen many successful people, and they have tried and failed a million times before they reached their goals.
- Newton: Maybe I should just give up my dream? Maybe I am not as good as my father
- Sun: It will be morning soon, You guys have to take a rest and let me shine!
- Mercury: Right, tell me how Newton behaves at school later!
- Mars: Trust me, you don't want to hear it...
