<u>Invitation to School Briefing Session on</u> 2024/25 Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach Programme

Seasonal influenza vaccination (SIV) is one of the most effective ways to prevent seasonal influenza and its complications. Vaccinating school-aged children can reduce students' absence from schools due to illness, lower influenza transmission in the community and most importantly reduce influenza-associated severe complications and deaths. Based on the latest local epidemiological data, majority of severe paediatric influenza cases have not received influenza vaccination. Hence, it is of paramount importance to encourage parents to arrange vaccination for their children early for season 2024/25 to enhance personal protection.

Schools are places where people gather and infectious diseases such as influenza could be easily spread among students through their daily contacts. Local experiences showed that schools which arranged outreach vaccination activities have doubled vaccination coverage rates among students, which effectively strengthens the immunity barrier. We are pleased to announce that through the collaborative efforts of participating schools, 80% of KGs, KG-cum-CCCs and CCCs in Hong Kong enrolled the Department of Health's SIV school outreach programmes in the 2023/24 season.
