Dear Principal/ Staff-in-charge of all Secondary Schools (including secondary section of Special Schools),

<u>Invitation to Participate in the</u> <u>Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination Catch-up Programme – Secondary School</u>

We are writing to invite all Secondary Schools to join the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination Catch-up Programme – Secondary School.

The Department of Health (DH) has launched the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination programme for eligible primary 5 and 6 school girls as part of the Hong Kong Childhood Immunisation Programme (HKCIP) since the 2019/2020 school year. In November 2022, the Scientific Committee on Vaccine Preventable Diseases (SCVPD) under the Centre for Health Protection of the DH recommended the extension of the HPV vaccination target group, to include older girls who were up to 18 years old, after reviewing scientific evidences regarding efficacy and safety of HPV vaccine, recommendations from the World Health Organization and overseas experiences, as well as local studies on acceptability and cost-effectiveness in respect of HPV vaccination.

In response to this recommendation, the Government plans to implement a one-off catch-up vaccination programme (the Programme) to provide mop-up HPV vaccination for eligible female secondary school students or older girls who were born in or after 2004 (i.e. those who were 18 years old or below in 2022 and were not covered by existing HPV vaccination programme).

II. Programme Arrangement

The mode of delivery of the Programme will be similar to the Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach (Free of Charge) Programme. Under the Programme, 2-dose HPV vaccination will be provided to eligible female students studying in and above S5 or equivalent grades in local secondary schools. The Programme will start in the 2024/25 school year and last until December 2026 for completion of two doses of vaccination. Your school is cordially invited to arrange outreach vaccination activities at school under the Programme.

Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) vaccination teams will be arranged to visit participating secondary schools to provide free outreach HPV vaccination services to eligible female students. Same as the Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach (Free of Charge) Programme, schools can self-select their service doctors, or ask DH to match a service doctor with the school. Relevant vaccination service is free of charge to schools and students.

Schools are reminded to stay clear of associating with any improper financial (or advantage) transactions when choosing your service doctors through School Self-selection of Doctors.

Please <u>complete the enrolment form Part I and II</u> to indicate your preference of outreach activities. For schools preferring **Self-selection of Doctors**,

please also complete the enrolment form Part III. Nil return is required (Please return enrolment form even if your school has already self-arranged vaccination activity).
