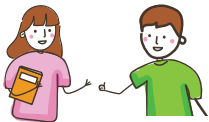


Meaning of Home-School Co-operation

- ✓ Helps parents and school understand children's needs and learning conditions
- ✓ Can enhance children's development and learning outcomes

The 4-Part Non-Violent Communication Process

1 Observations



Not to make hasty comments

2 Feelings



No subjective thinking or opinions

3 Needs



Stemmed from observations and feelings, not goal-oriented strategies

4 Requests



No reprimand nor orders, but positive, specific and doable requests

In a disagreement



Find a quiet place, take a friendly attitude



Be a listener and share information
